## Vegreville & Area FASD Community of Practice

What is a Community of Practice? Communities of Practice help develop members' expertise and define their place or role in community. They are created because of the commitment and identification of a need that forms the basis of the practice. Communities of Practice will continue as long as members have an interest in improving practice and maintaining community (<http://www.nickols.us/CoPCharacteristics.htm>)

The Vegreville and Area FASD Community of Practice (CoP) believes that to create a successful FASD CoP all members must have a shared understanding of FASD and FASD Intervention. To meet this need it was decided that two days of FASD Training was required.

Day 1 would focus on the theory of FASD Intervention and Day 2 would focus on putting into practice what we had learned on Day 1 through guided case consultation with support from an expert in the field (Donna Debolt). Members of the CoP would commit to meeting on a regular basis to support one another in case consultation and by building their knowledge and understanding of FASD.
